REGISTER

Create an account by visiting **myhero.com/audio** and clicking on Register.

The registration page asks for relevant information such as your name, grade, school, and email address. This information is only used to contact users when their audio is featured on our site, and will not be given to any third party. Students may use a school contact or email address, rather than their own, in the requested field.

Teachers and after-school program instructors using this project in their classroom should ask all participating students to identify the name of the school or organization in the requested "organization field" on the registration page.

GUIDELINES FOR CREATING YOUR AUDIO

Record your **original** music, story, poetry, news report, interview or commentary in an **Mp3 format.** The file size must be less than 50MB.

MY HERO will not exhibit any audio that promotes hatred, violence or prejudice.

MY HERO will not knowingly exhibit any audio that has been plagiarized or reproduced from another website or from any other source.

All audio published on MY HERO must be appropriate for all age viewers, including children.

STEPS TO UPLOADING YOUR AUDIO

If you have already registered with a username and password, click **MY AUDIO** to log in.

Click the **arrow button** and select an **Mp3** file from your computer to upload to the MY HERO server.

On the next page, **add information** about your hero audio, including the title, medium, artist, credits and description.

Click **Customize Page** to add images and related links to your audio page.

Click **Preview Audio Page** to see how your audio file will appear on MY HERO. If you are satisfied with your audio page, click **Submit Audio Page**. If you would like to continue working on it, click **Edit Audio Page**.

Be sure to click **Submit Audio Page** when you are finished!

All submitted content to MY HERO is reviewed by MY HERO editors before it is activated for public viewing on the website.

If you included an email address when you registered to upload audio, you will receive an email notifying you when your audio page has been activated on the MY HERO Audio Studio.

Outstanding MY HERO audio contributions will be featured on MY HERO and awarded prizes.
